

PMC's ESG due diligence process aims to evaluate intentionality in the manager's investment process, and a commitment to systematic integration of ESG information. To uncover high conviction ESG focused managers, PMC has implemented a framework that focuses on four key components.

Professional asset management

Capital Markets Assumptions (CMAs) and Asset Allocation

PMC's forward-looking CMAs and asset allocation methodology are the foundation of portfolio construction. CMAs inform portfolio construction, risk measures, asset allocation models, and portfolio wealth forecasts.

Diversified, risk-based portfolios

ESG Due Diligence on Managers

Envestnet | PMC Research incorporates an additional layer of analysis within its comprehensive research and due diligence process to uncover high-conviction equity and fixed income managers that are systematically integrating ESG information into the investment process. This is done by evaluating firm-level governance of ESG, ESG integration into the investment process, reporting on ESG outcomes, and engagement on ESG issues. The team collects information through due diligence questionnaires and ongoing conversations with management teams.
